Standards:

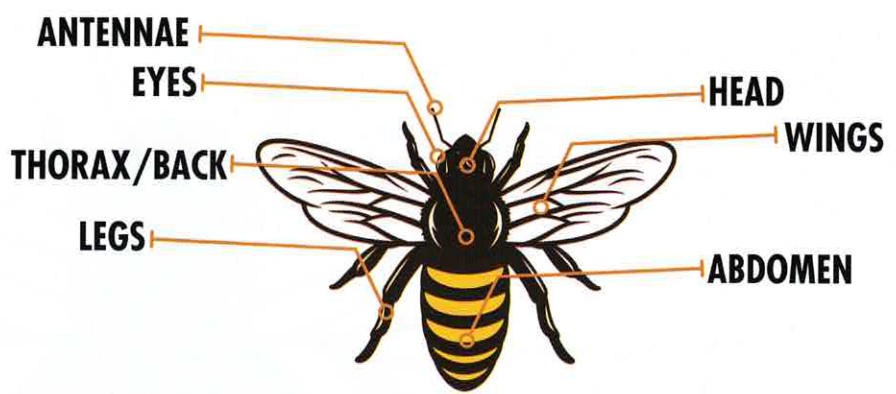

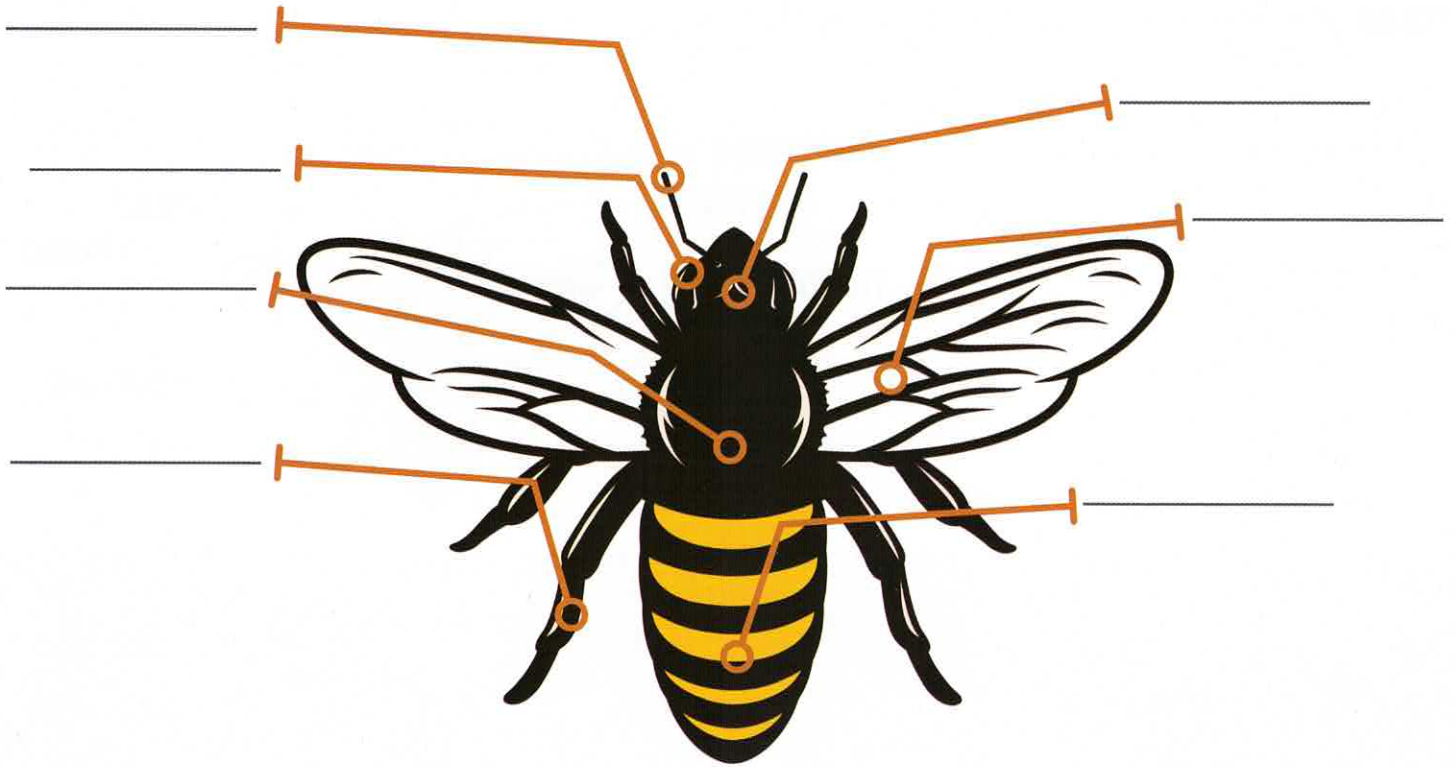
Procedure:

1. Read "Honeybee: The Busy Life of *Apis Mellifera*" out loud to the class.
2. Discuss with the students the different parts of a bee mentioned in the story and what their purpose is.
 - Eyes
 - Head
 - Antennae
 - Wings
 - Abdomen
 - Thorax/back
3. Give students the worksheet to label the parts of the bee.
